This answer key is provided as a guide for the corrector. Answers should be graded on basic content rather than specific wording in most cases. Please refer to the KJV, NIV or other versions of the Bible as an additional reference.

CHAPTER 15

1. you hypocrites, this people draw near unto me (honor me) with their lips but their hearts are far from me
2. that which comes out of the (his) mouth

2. He cleansed the temple by throwing out the money changers, those who bought and sold and Jesus said: "It is written, My house shall be called a house of prayer."
3. He healed them
4. answers may vary - He frequented the temple and His custom was going to the synagogue, the place of worship
5. they were displeased (indignant)
6. Simon the leper, Mary, Martha and Lazarus
7. accept any answer based on the fig tree having no figs, withering (drying up) and Jesus' lesson of faith
8. believing
9. answers will vary, they were tempting Jesus trying to trap Him
10. answers will vary, accept any answer based on the parable of the two sons
11. answers will vary, accept any answer based on the parable of the husbandman (landholder)
12. Jesus was talking about the Pharisees and they wanted to lay hands on Him and arrest Him
13. they feared the multitude (crowd) because they considered Jesus to be a prophet

CHAPTER 22

1. because knowledge of the mysteries (secrets) of the kingdom of heaven was given to Jesus' disciples but not to the Jewish leaders
2. they made light of it (paid no attention), one went to his farm (fields) and another went to his merchandising (business)
3. they took them, mistreated them and killed them
4. the king was wroth (enraged) and sent his army and destroyed the murderers and their city
5. he didn't have on a wedding garment, he was bound hand and foot and cast into outer darkness
6. many are called, few are chosen

7. they were trying to trap Jesus with His words
8. Whose image (portrait) and inscription was on the coin? Caesar's
9. they marveled (were amazed)
10. they were astonished at His doctrine (teaching) - they were silenced
11. love God with all your heart and love your neighbor as yourself

14. he will be giving meat (food) to the servants under him and will be put in charge of (made ruler) over all his goods (possessions)
15. answers will vary, accept any answer based on verse 51

7. watch and pray so you will not fall (enter) into temptation
8. the flesh (the body)

10. Peter, Jesus touched the ear and healed it
11. pray to His Father and receive 12 legions of angels
12. answers will vary, accept any answer based on Peter's 3-time denial of Jesus and Peter's repentance
