This answer key is provided as a guide for the corrector. Answers should be graded on basic content rather than specific wording in most cases. Please refer to the KJV, NIV or other versions of the Bible as an additional reference.

28. no razor was to be used on his head, he was to be a Nazirite, he was to be set apart to God from birth

 115. deacons
 116. Older men: exhort them as fathers, do not rebuke them
 Younger men: treat them as brothers
 Older women: treat them as mothers
 Younger women: treat them as sisters with absolute purity
 Widows in need: (honor) give proper recognition to those in need

117. wording may vary: children and grandchildren should first learn to put their religion into practice by caring for their own family, repaying them and pleasing God
118. Older men: teach them to be sober, grave, temperate (self controlled), worthy of respect, sound in faith, in love and in patience (endurance)
Older women: teach them to be reverent (holy) in their behavior, not slanderers (false accusers), not addicted to much wine, but teachers of good things
